Dependent Healthcare Costs to Skyrocket if Prop. B Passes

Under the guise of pension 'reform,' San Francisco Public Defender Jeff Adachi has placed a charter amendment on the ballot that if passed will have grave consequences for SFUSD teachers, paraprofessionals, and other school workers' healthcare costs.

How bad is it? All active educators and retirees will end up paying up to \$1,500 more per year to cover their dependents, because of changes written into the amendment to the Health Services System.

Health care costs for educators with dependants is already expensive. Raising the yearly payments by \$1,500 will mean many of us will be unable to provide coverage for our children.

Fortunately, UESF is leading the charge to stop the dangerous initiative from passing. Along with the SF Labor Council, UESF is developing a detailed plan to turn out a record number of volunteers to defeat the healthcare attack.
