



Resolution in Support of Occupy San Francisco

Passed by the UESF Executive Board on November 2, 2011. To be considered by the UESF Assembly for final approval on November 16, 2011.

Whereas the San Francisco Labor Council (SFLC) mobilized leadership and membership to protect the Occupy San Francisco encampment, and

Whereas UESF and SFLC leadership responded by forming a human barricade at the entrance to the encampment, and consequently there was no raid, and

Whereas for the Occupy movement to win, labor will need to continue to play a key role,

Therefore be it resolved that UESF shall support SFLC's call for support of Occupy San Francisco, with up to no more than \$1000/month, and

Therefore be it resolved that the UESF president appoint a coordinator for Occupy SF support work, and

Be it resolved that UESF urge members to participate in union Thursdays at Occupy SF, and

Be it further resolved that UESF shall coordinate outreach to members with SFLC, using all communication resources available, and

Be it resolved that UESF create a telephone/electronic phone tree of members who commit to be part of an emergency response to defend Occupy SF, and

Be it finally resolved that UESF shall maintain contact with the Oakland/Alameda Labor Council and its support for Occupy Oakland and shall inform the UESF membership of those activities.
