


# **Our Campaign Continues**

United Educators of San Francisco is moving into the the next phase of our campaign to engage our community around issues that impact, not only educators and students, but working families throughout San Francisco. We are aggressively moving forward with a new parcel tax to maintain quality local education and give students the tools they need to succeed. Through this new parcel tax, we will see substantial wage increases and compensation for our members, including all paras, early educators and substitutes.

### Why a Parcel Tax?

California school districts are directly impacted by changes in state revenues. Unlike other states that can raise property taxes to fund various public services, California has severe limits since the passage of Proposition 13. Parcel taxes provide some of the few exceptions where we can engage our community around support for public schools in our city and secure funding to maintain quality education.

#### K-12 Revenue


